2022-2023 Scholarship Guidelines

Each year, the Woman's Wednesday Club ("WWC") awards thousands of dollars in scholarships to young women who are future community leaders. The scholarships are \$1,500-\$4,000 for full time and part time students.

ELIGIBILITY FOR WWC SCHOLARSHIPS

Applicants must:

- A. Be a female resident of Hood County
- B. **Legacy Scholarship**
 - a. Be a full-time Sophomore, Junior or Senior at a four-year college or university
 - b. Have at least a 2.5 grade point average
- C. **New Horizons Scholarship**
 - a. Be a full or part-time student returning to college after a pause
- D. **Granbury Scholarship**
 - a. Be a full or part-time student at Weatherford College
- E. **Pathways Scholarship**
 - a. Be a High School Senior who will be a full-time student at a four-year college or university.
- F. **Master Class Scholarship**
 - a. Be a full-time student who has successfully completed a Bachelor's degree and is now pursuing a Graduate degree.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Each Applicant must:

- A. Meet the above eligibility criteria;
- B. Submit a complete **Scholarship Application Packet**, consisting of;
 - 1. A Scholarship Data Form;
 - 2. A personal statement of the applicant's goals related to the applicant's future career and the applicant's future commitment to public / community service;
 - 3. A resume' including the applicant's educational accomplishments and service to the community (applicant may include both high school and college accomplishments and service); and
 - 4. **Legacy Scholarship Only** - An official certified college/university transcript documenting completed credit hours and GPA
- C. Scholarship Application Packet components 1 – 4 must be submitted together. The official transcript (4) may be submitted separately, depending on university policy.
- D. *By submitting a Scholarship Application Packet, scholarship winners consent to having their names, photographs, name of college, and college major published in the WWC Newsletter and published in conjunction with the WWC Scholarship Fundraiser.*

Note: The Scholarship Committee will not consider incomplete applications.
